Notice Regarding 2019-2020 School Closure April 10, 2020

Due to Governor Parsons closing schools for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year, the following information is being provided to parents and students regarding class assignments and final semester grades:

Second Semester Grades

Students 3rd Quarter grades will be used for their Spring Semester grades. Students who received a failing grade in a class for the 3rd Quarter will need to turn in their Student Enrichment Packets by May 15th for those classes in order to receive a passing grade for the Spring Semester. There is a drop box in front of the High School Main Entrance for this purpose. All seniors in good standing at the end of the 3rd Quarter have met the requirements for graduation. All students in good standing at the end of the 3rd Quarter will be promoted to the next grade level.

Student Enrichment Packets

Cooter R-4 School District will be distributing Student Enrichment Packets on Monday, April 20th in the Cafeteria from 8:00-3:00. In order to comply with Social Distancing Guidelines, we will only allow one person in the Cafeteria at a time. Please wait outside or in your vehicle until the person ahead of you has left the Cafeteria. If you are unable to pick up at this time, please contact me or Mr. Shubert, and we will arrange to meet you.

These Student Enrichment Packets will provide instruction through Friday, May 15th, as recommended by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. We encourage all students to complete these packets to the best of their abilities. For students in good standing at the end of the 3rd Quarter, the packets will not be turned in or graded but are meant for enrichment.
